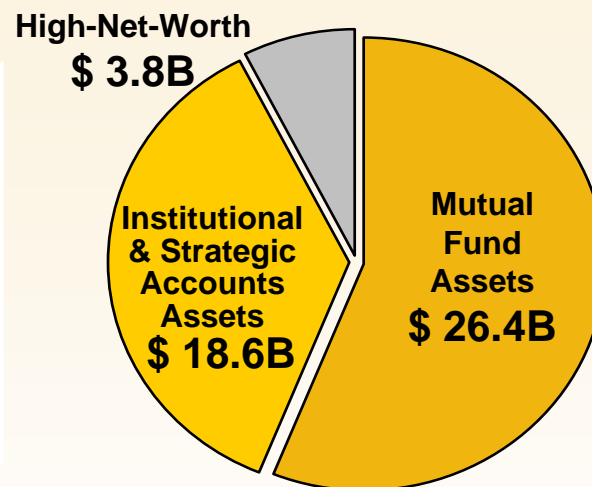

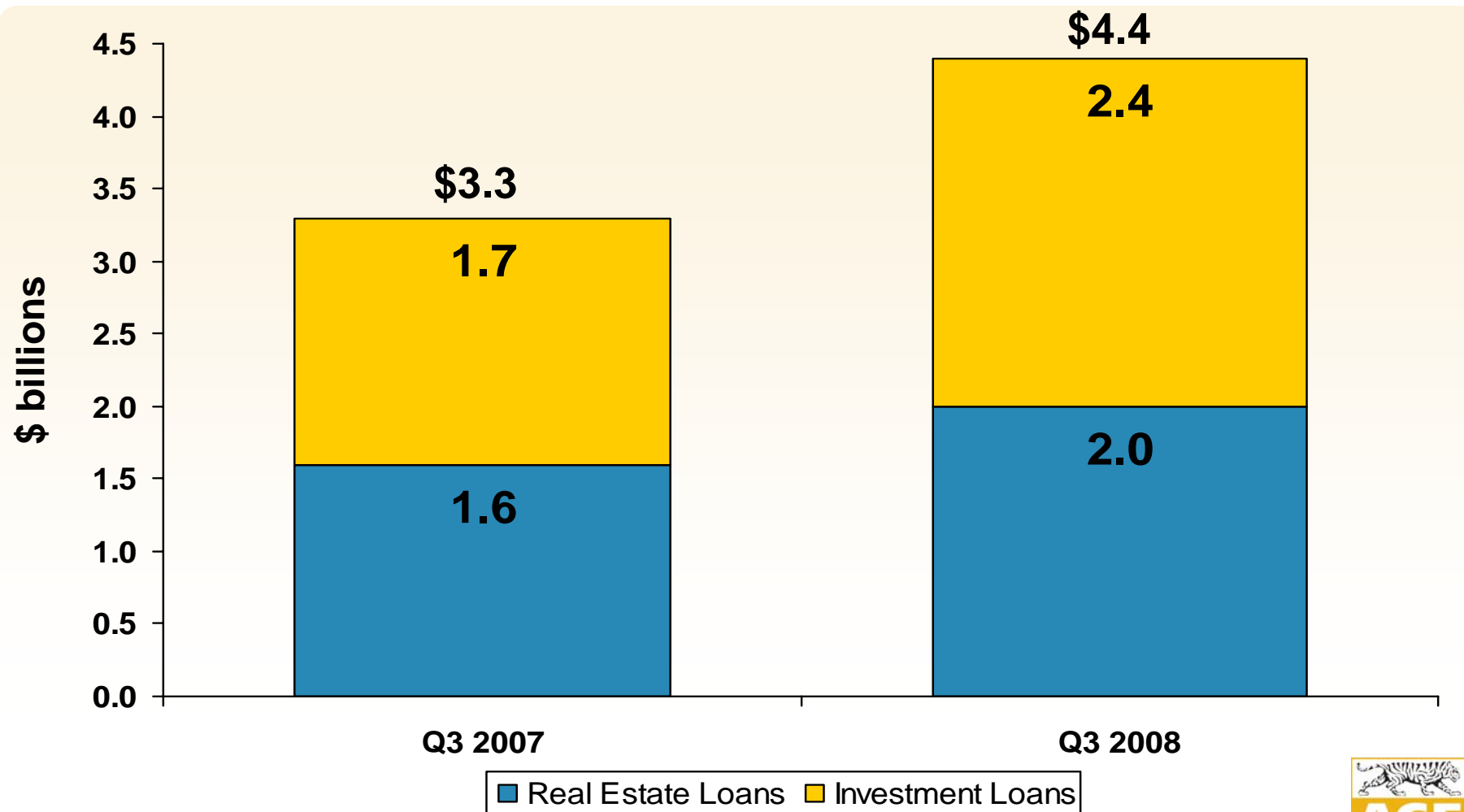

FINANCIAL HIGHLIGHTS COMPARED TO Q3 2007

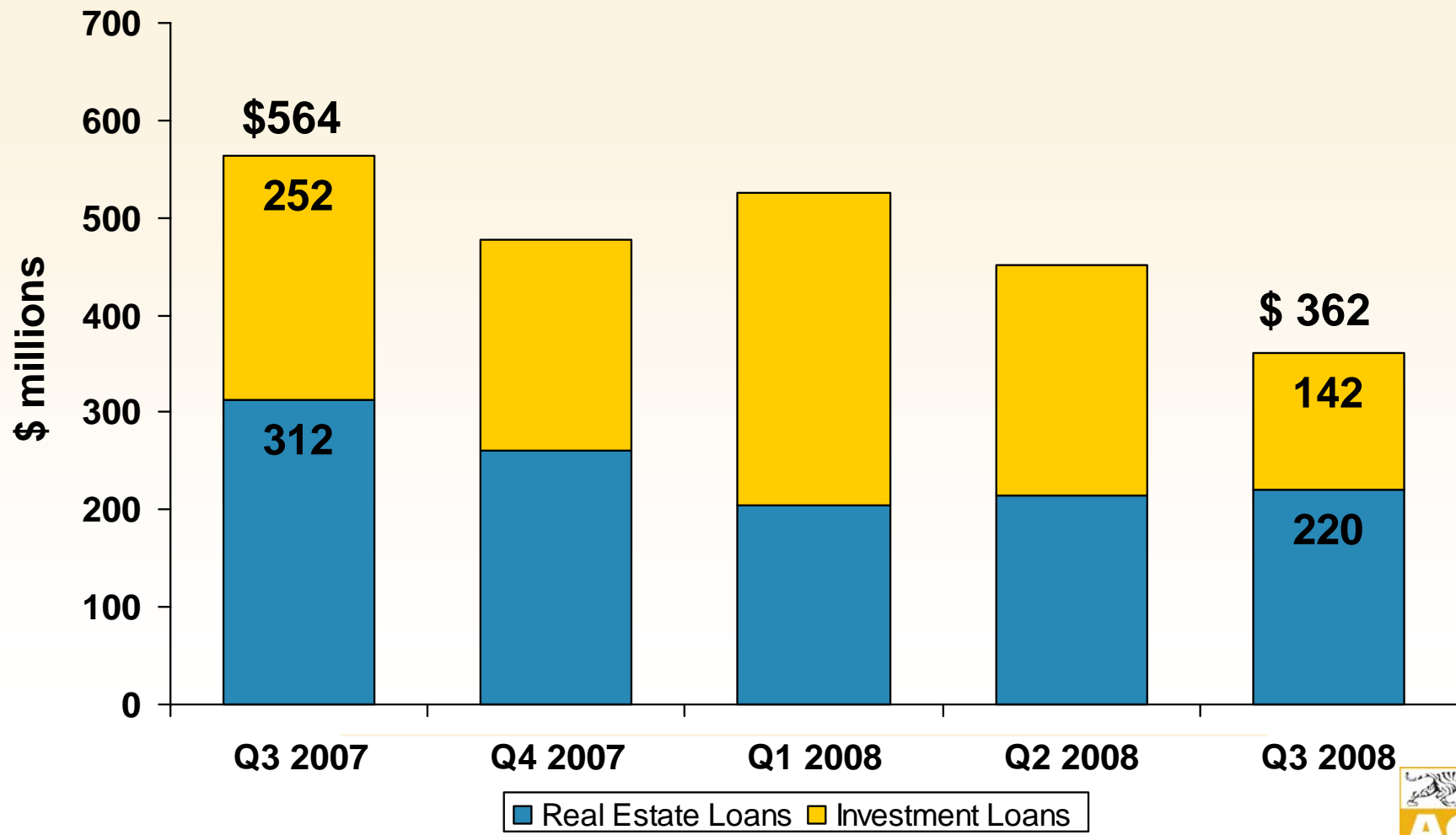
AUM decreased	9.4 %

Long-term Debt reduced	12.6 %



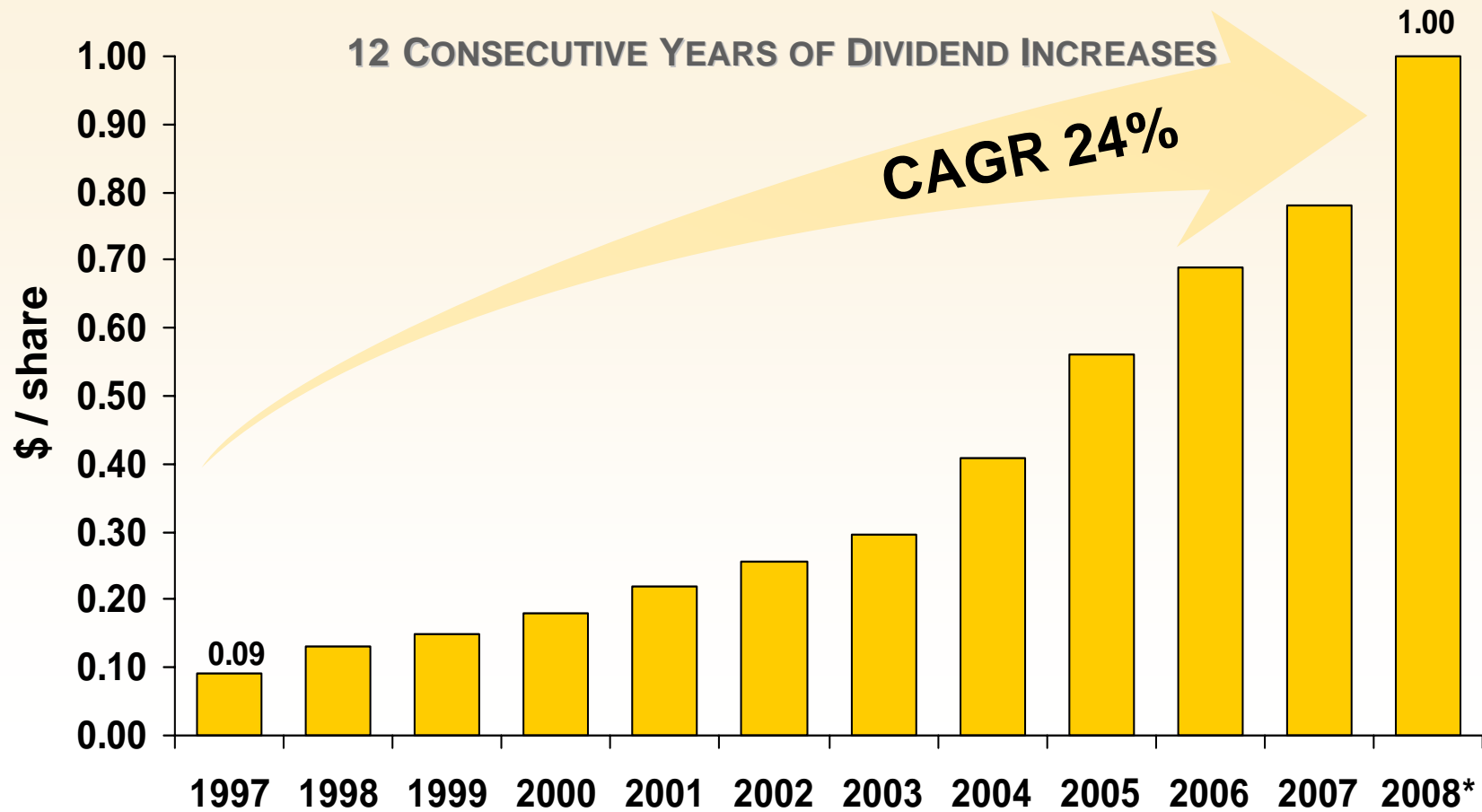
AGF MANAGEMENT LIMITED: TRUST LOAN ASSETS



AGF TRUST COMPANY: GROSS LOAN ORIGINATIONS



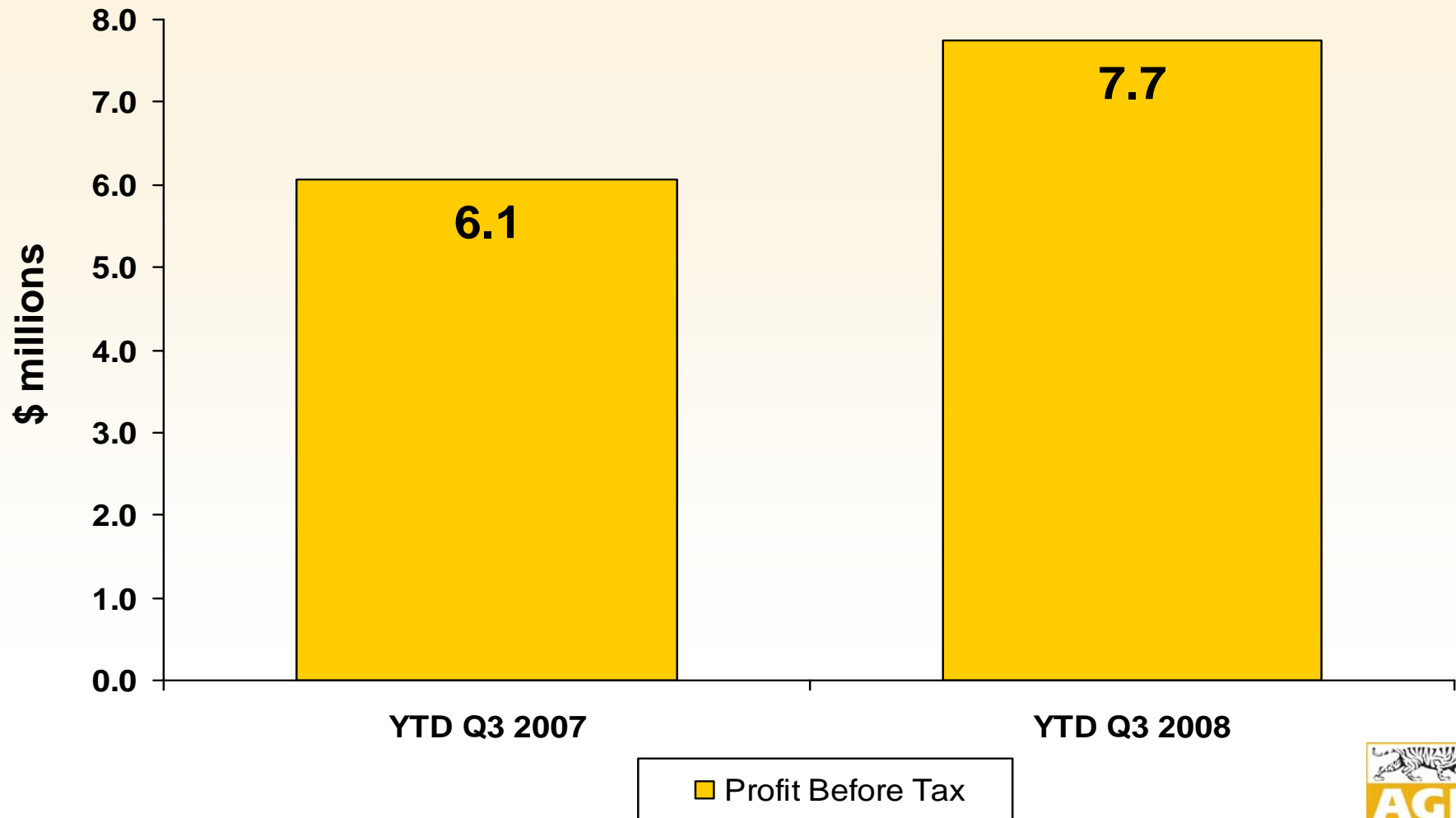
CAPITAL STEWARDSHIP: DIVIDENDS



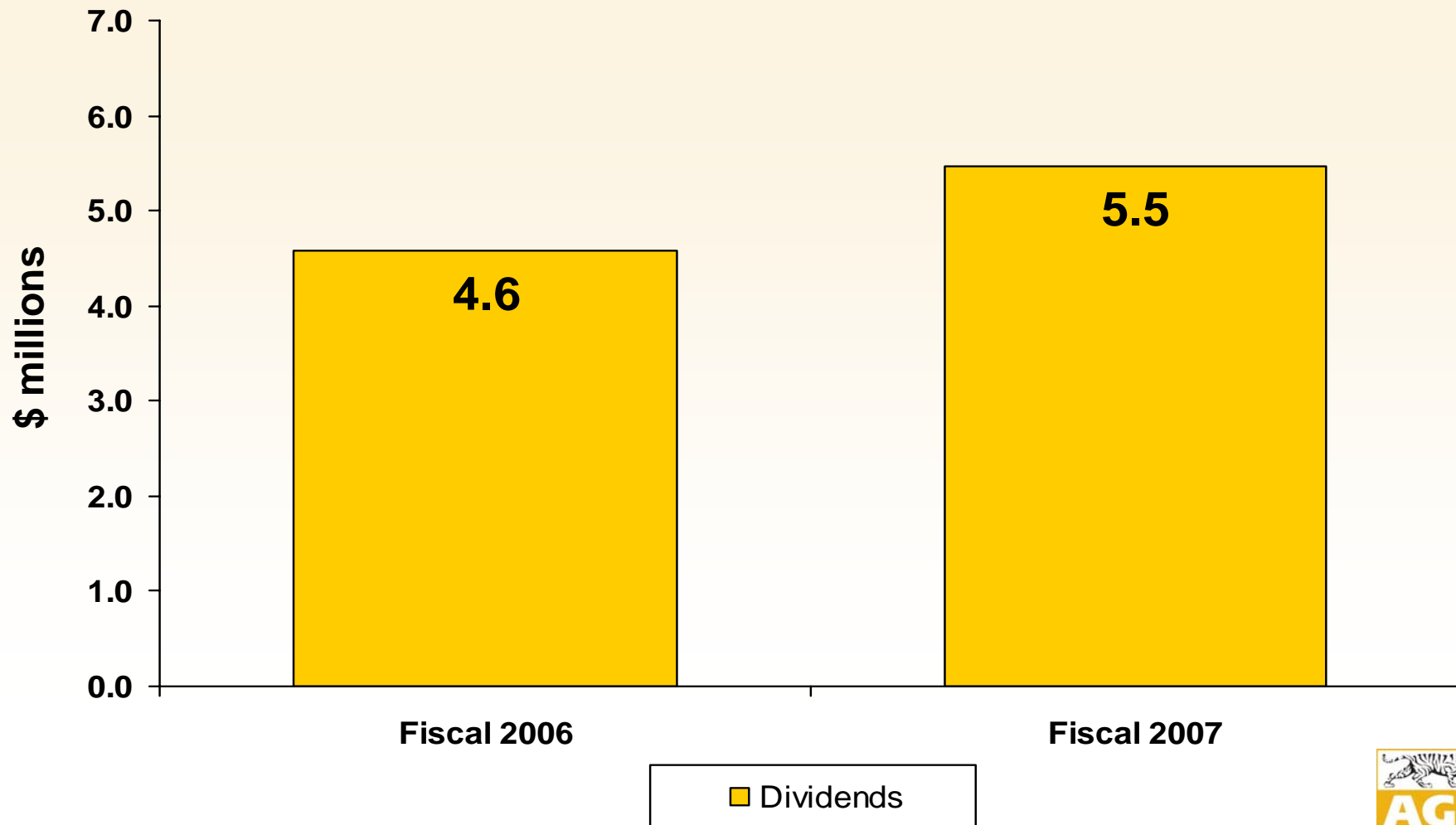

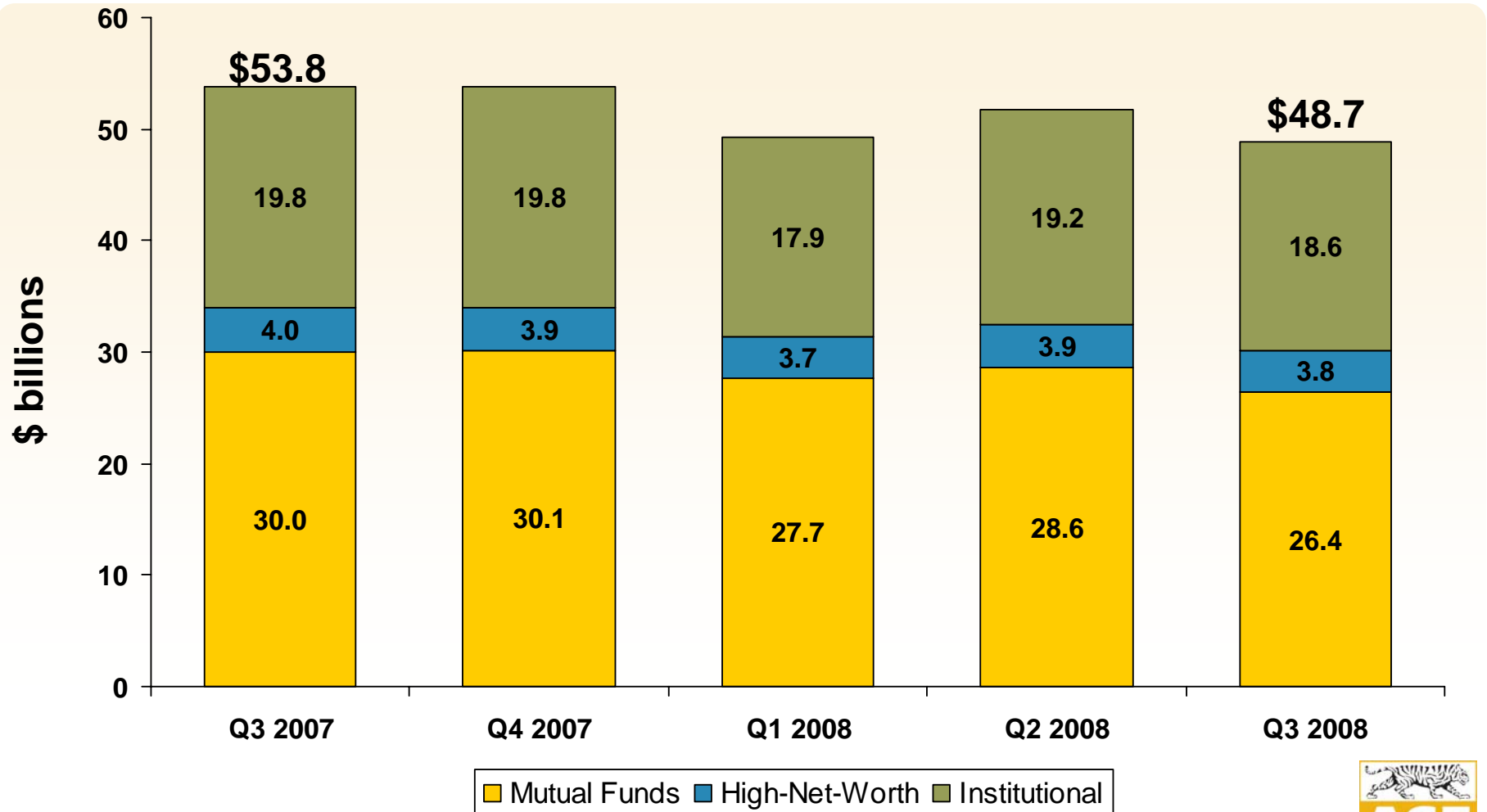
AGF MANAGEMENT LIMITED: SMITH AND WILLIAMSON – PROFIT BEFORE TAX



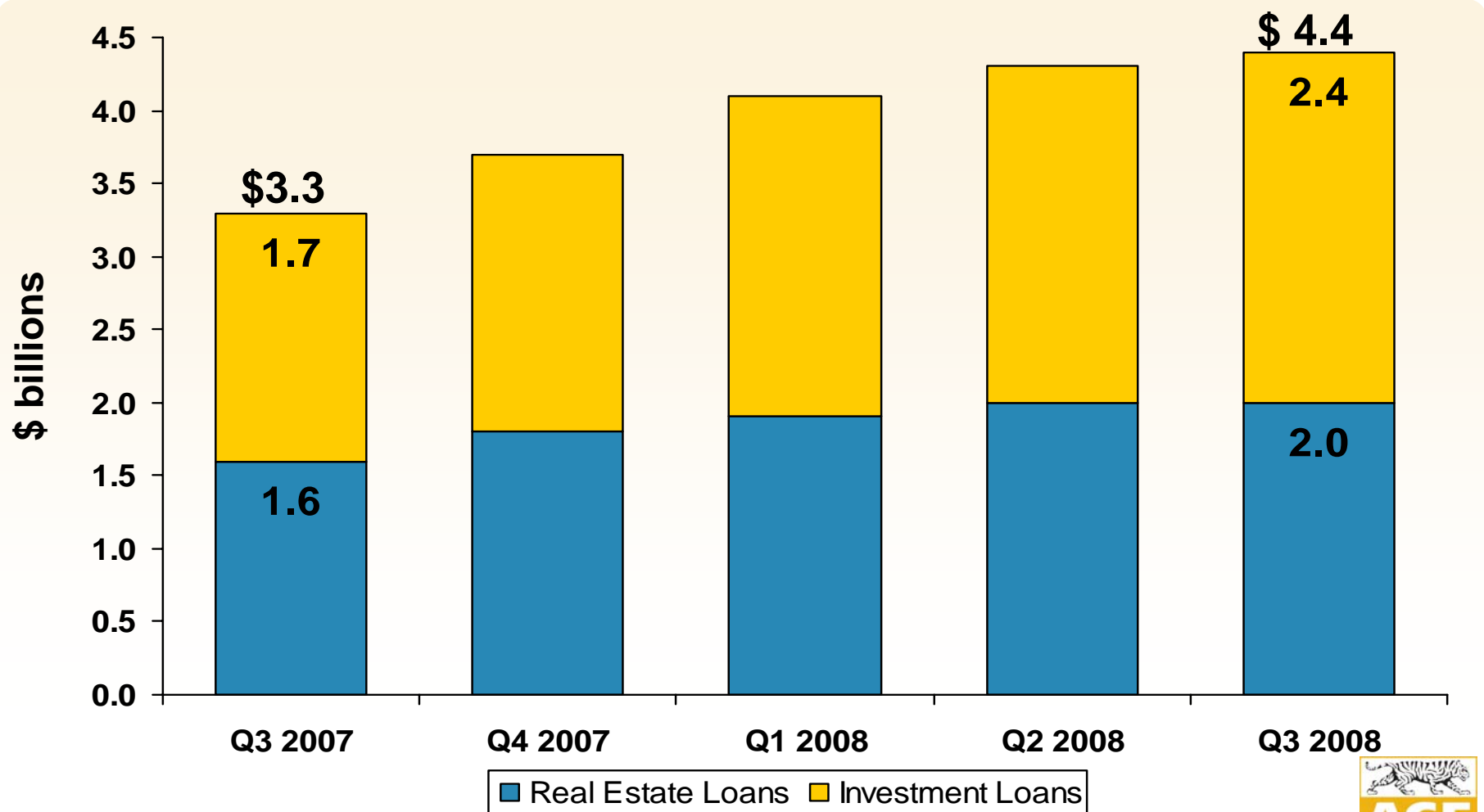
AGF MANAGEMENT LIMITED: SMITH AND WILLIAMSON – DIVIDENDS PAID



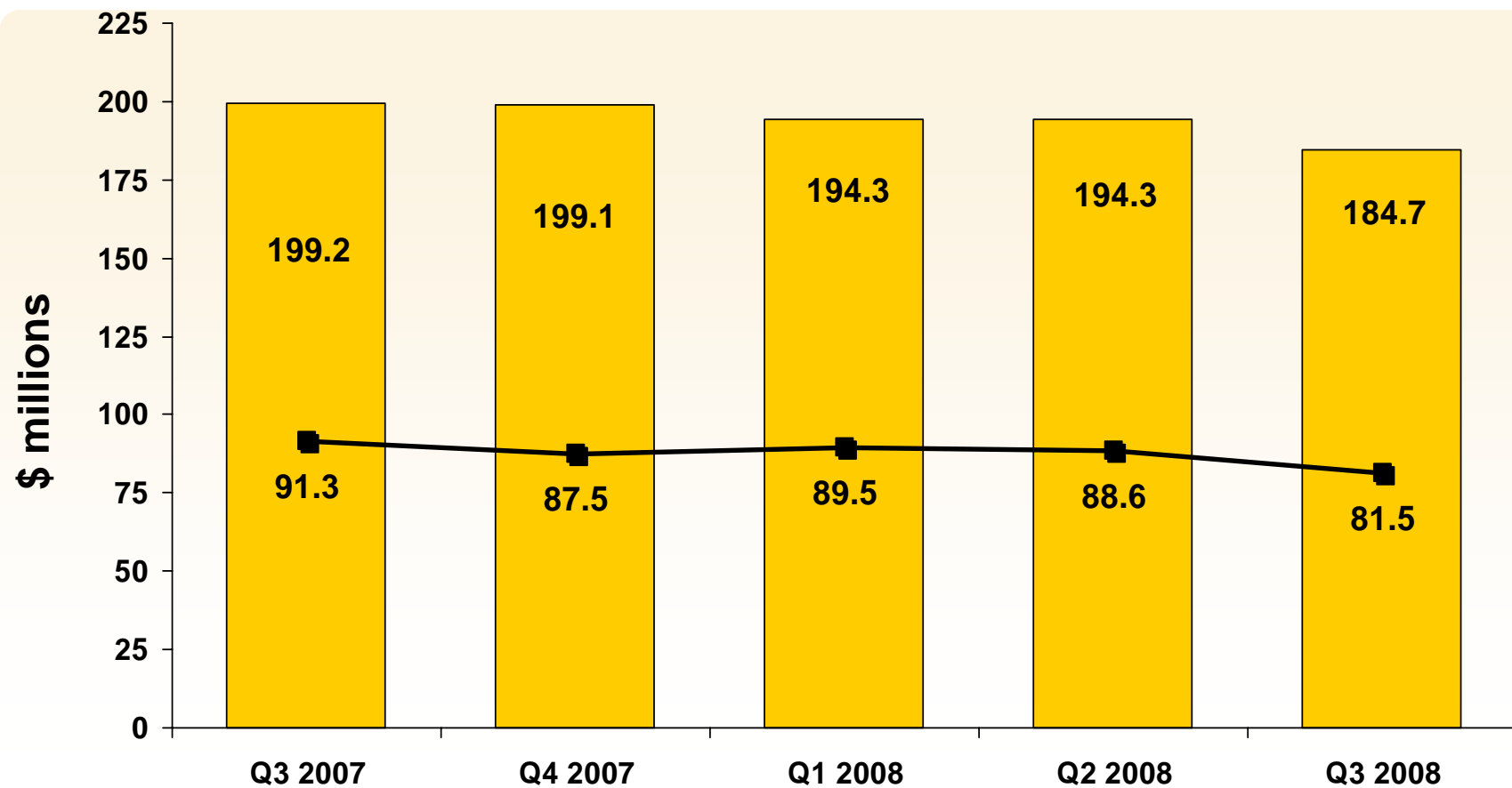
INVESTMENT MANAGEMENT: ASSETS UNDER MANAGEMENT (AUM)

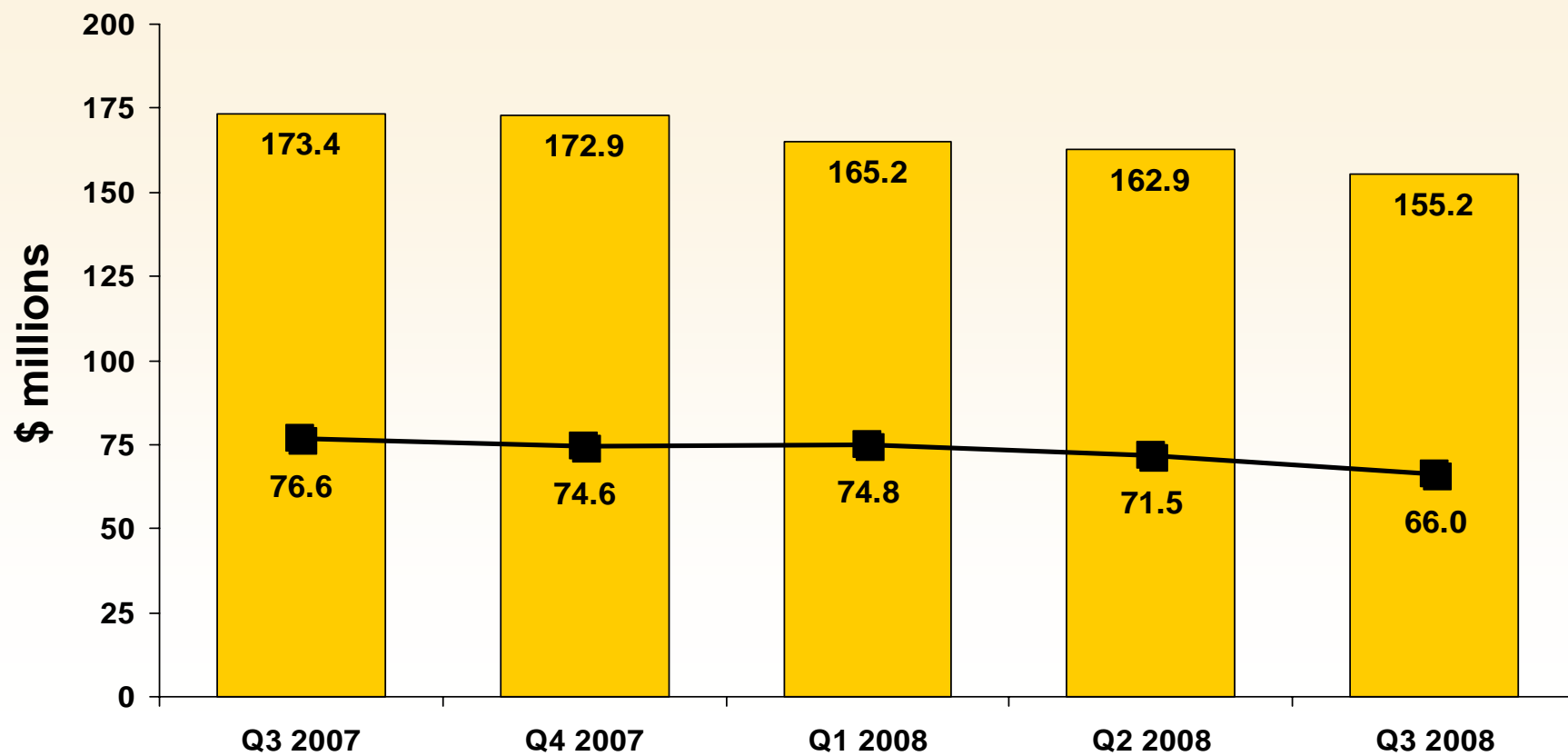

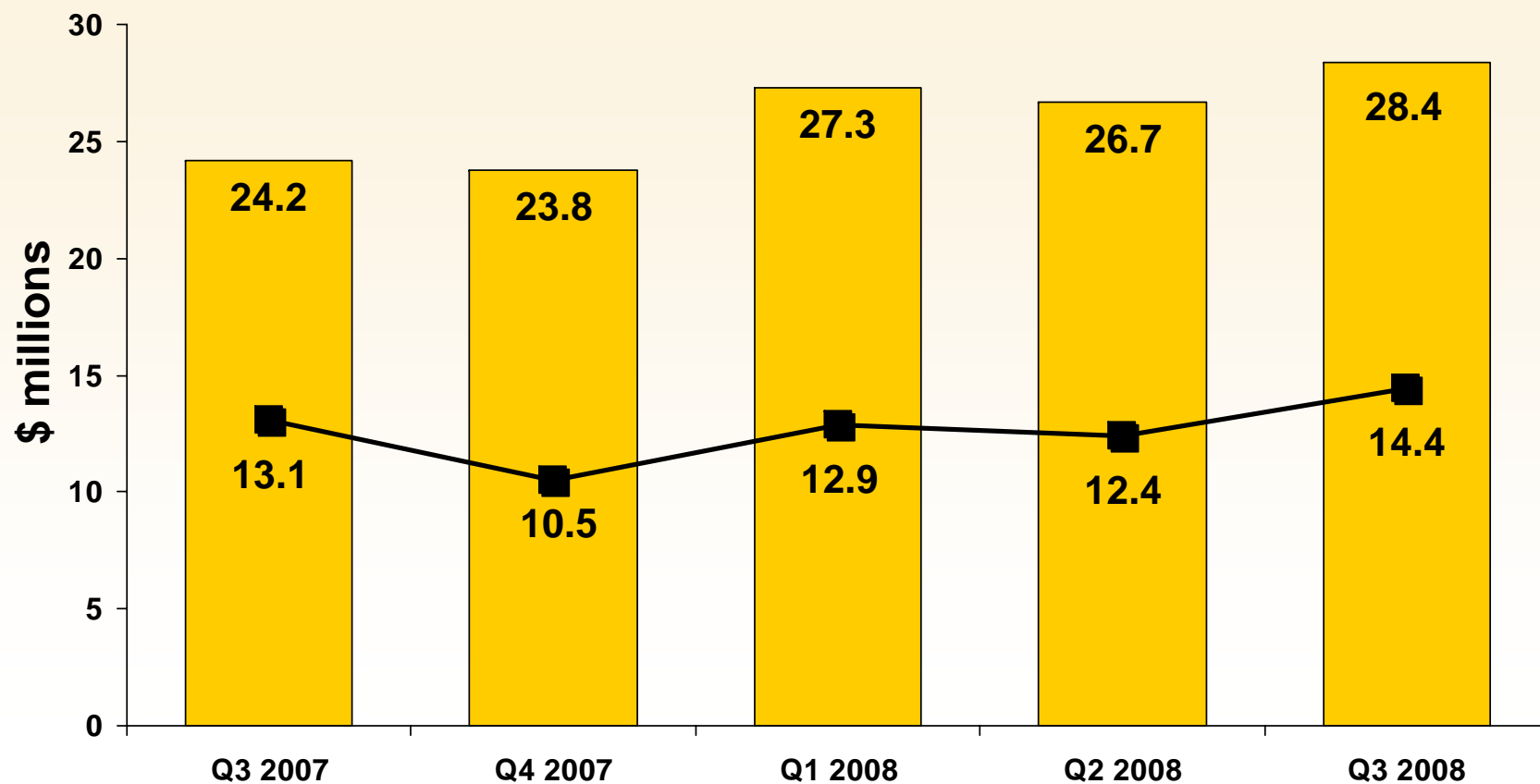

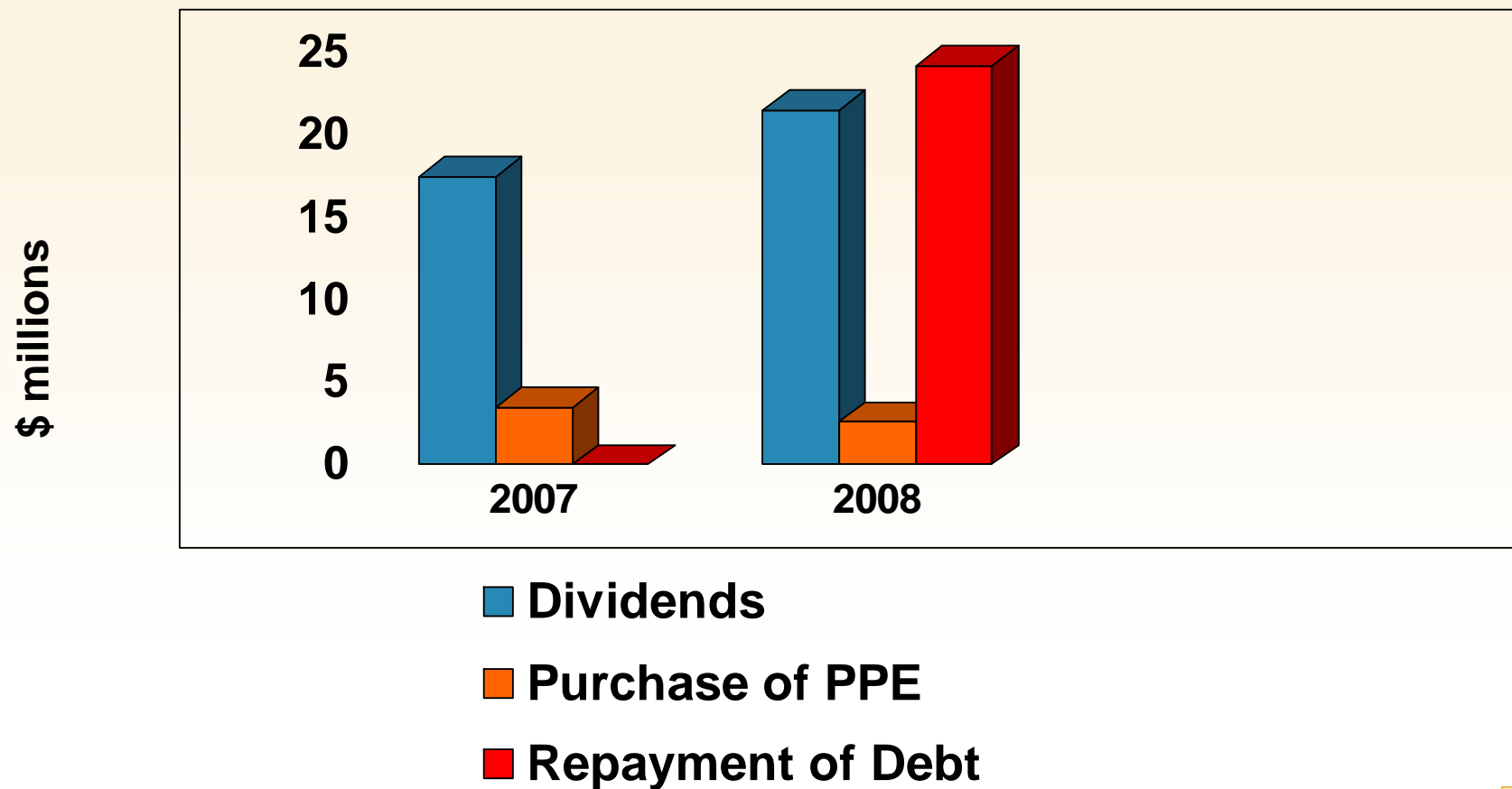
